HANDS ON

Using the Kelton System, Bob Pegram cored a large Box Elder bowl blank, making 3 bowls from one piece. Initially using laser guidance, he cut deeply into the blank, then pryed it out. After preparing the inner piece, he repeated the process to get a third bowl blank.

Don Schultz demonstrated pen turning without a mandrel. He had precision-made bushings and used his lathe-mounted pen press to make several pens.

Wayne Kuhn turned a screwdriver handle from a laminated blank. He rounded it over then made well measured cuts to accept the ferrule.

He screwed on a flare nut for a ferrule and knocked off the hex sides with a blunt gouge followed by a file. He had help in shaping it, then sanded it and finished it. The only step remaining would be epoxying in the screwdriver insert.


